

VENUE

The Symposium will be held at the Skede (Šķēde) Forest Research Station "Mezmaja" 120 km from Riga <u>http://www.latvia.travel/lv/naktsmitne/mezmaja</u> (in Latvian).

"Mezmaja" is a training center for forestry students, located in a picturesque area 7.5 km from Talsi town <u>http://www.talsi.lv/talsi-city-eng</u>

The complex consists of three buildings: "Hunters" is an office for Skede forest district foresters and "Mezmaja" with the conference building and accommodation area.

Dendrological plantations (including the first beech cultures) in Skede were set up in 1885. Total area of Skede forest district takes up to 2489 hectares. The climate, soil and growth conditions here are suitable for local and introduced trees. The main species are spruce (43.2%), birch (32.8%) and pine (16.5%). The most important introduced species are beech, red oak, fir, larch, Douglas fir, cedar and hornbeam. Location: "Mezmaja", Lauciene Rural territory, Talsi region http://www.talsi.lv/novads-eng
